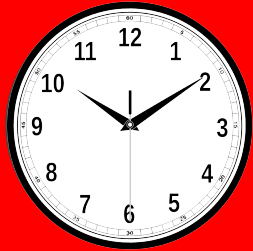

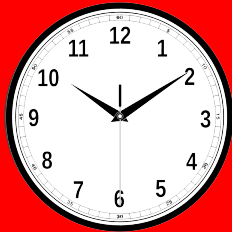



EXPECTATION: Attend class daily

Attendance is taken within the first ten minutes of every class period.

You are expected to be present for the entire class period unless otherwise instructed by your teacher. Any student who leaves class without permission may be marked absent by the teacher.

Assignments submitted without class attendance (unexcused absence) may not be accepted or graded.

EXPECTATION: Have your camera ON and engage in class



NEW!

In order to be considered present for class, you must **turn on your camera*** (or microphone) and you must answer questions when asked by the teacher.

If your teacher has no evidence that you are actually present in front of your screen, and if you do not interact (voice or chat), you may be marked absent.

**Plug-and-play webcams have been ordered for students with broken Chromebook cameras. We will let you know when they can be picked up.*

EXPECTATION: Having your camera turned on

We recognize that some of you do not have working cameras at this time. You will need to communicate this with Mrs. Clancy and your teacher so we can address this challenge.

We also understand that having a camera on can make some of us uncomfortable. As we shift to full remote, it is important for us to see and hear you in order determine if you are understanding the material. If you have a specific concern, please reach out to your teacher so you can work together.

EXPECTATION: Be on time and ready to learn

Show respect to your teacher and classmates:

- Be online and logged in at the beginning of class. Any absence from class or late arrival is unexcused unless arranged in advance by your parent or guardian.
- Get dressed and sit upright, with a table or desk space to work. Your bed is not an appropriate learning space.

EXPECTATION: Do your best

This is a tough time for all of us. We all need to dig deep and be strong. School matters.

After the pandemic, our world will need educated young people more than ever. The habits you set now will affect you far into the future. Don't give up. Get organized. Ask for help. Discipline yourself and make school important.

We want you to succeed. We are here for you.

EXPECTATION: Complete your work on time

All current late work is due no later than December 11. Due dates for pending work stand.

Going forward, your teacher may not accept work turned in after a deadline, and you will need to work with your teacher individually to demonstrate competency for missing assignments.

This is a student's responsibility. Ask for help *before* you miss a deadline.

EXPECTATION: Be advised about failures and credit recovery

You will be allowed to fail. Teachers and staff are providing instruction, support, and extra help, and you have a responsibility to be an active, engaged student. Every student who attends class regularly, puts in effort, and works proactively with their teacher can succeed.

In the event of failure, summer school will be offered (for those who meet the criteria) and/or you may need to repeat a course.
