- CARES Act ESSER I
 - \$15,200.88
- CRRSA Act ESSER II
 - \$57,788.52
- ARP Act ESSER III
 - \$129,912.53
- Total ESSER Grants Awarded to Washington
 - \$202,901.93

Important Information About ESSER Funds

- 20% of funding from ESSER II & III must be spent on address learning loss through evidence based interventions. 20% = \$37,540.27
- ESSER I must be used by September 30, 2022
- ESSER II must be used by September 30, 2023
- ESSER III must be used by September 30, 2024

Allowable Activities Under CARES Act ESSER I

- Coordination of preparedness and response efforts of Local Education Agency (LEA) with state, local, public health dept., to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus.
- Provide resources for principals and other school leaders to address school specific needs.
- Activities that address unique needs of our students.
- Developing and implementing procedures and systems to improve the preparedness and response efforts for the LEAs.
- Training and professional development of staff on sanitation and minimizing the spread of infectious disease.
- Purchasing supplies to sanitize and clean facilities.

Allowable Activities Under CARES Act ESSER I

- Planning and coordination during long-term closures.
- Purchasing educational technology.
- Providing mental health services.
- Planning and implementing summer learning and supplemental afterschool programs.
- Other activities necessary to maintain the operation of and continuity of services in LEA's and continuing to employ existing staff.

CARES Act ESSER I Budgeted Activities

- Student & District Services
 - Summer 2021 Jump Start Kindergarten Program
 - FirstStudent additional cleaning on buses.
 - District leadership team to design re-entry plan
- Technology
 - 8 zoom subscriptions used for Hybrid instruction.
- Furniture & Facilities
 - Purchase cleaning & PPE supplies.

Allowable Activities Under CRRSA Act ESSER II

- ESSER II includes all the activities listed in ESSER I and the ones listed below.
- Addressing learning loss among all students.
 - Administering reliable assessments that can assess student academic progress and assist educators in meeting students needs.
 - Implementing evidence-based activities to meet the comprehensive needs of the student.
 - Providing information and assistance to parents and families on ways to support students.
 - Tracking student performance and engagement in distance learning environments.
- School facility repairs and improvements to enable operation of schools to reduce risk of virus transmission and exposure to environmental health hazards and support student health needs.
- Inspecting, testing, maintaining, repairing, replacing, and upgrading projects to improve the indoor air quality in school facilities.
 - HVAC Systems, filtering purification, and other air cleaning, fans, control systems, and window and door replacement

CRRSA Act ESSER II Budgeted Activities

- Addressing learning loss among all students.
 - Hiring a part time special education para for the 21-22 school year.
 - Summer program targeted for Responsive to Intervention (RTL)Support.
 - Compensatory Education Costs.
 - Hire part time special education teacher.

Allowable Activities Under CRRSA Act ESSER III

- ESSER III Includes all of the ESSER I & II items except for providing resources for principals and other school leaders. It also includes one additional item.
- Development of strategies and implementation of public protocols that align with the CDC prevention guidance on reopening and operating of school facilities to maintain the health and safety of students, educators, and other staff.
