Purpose

As we transition deeper into competency based grading, and continue to raise expectations of our students, we will be assigning summer concept review. This review is intended to prepare you for Algebra, and not force us to spend a month, or more, reviewing Pre-Algebra content, allowing us to progress further into the Algebra content, better preparing you for the SAT, and for future math courses.

Therefore, this summer review work is not optional. Failure to do this work will put you behind the remainder of the students, and make the initial content more difficult for you.

When we return to school in the fall we will spend up to one class reviewing each chapter, four classes total. The fifth class of the year will be an assessment of the first four units covered in the review.
